Introduction: Finding Divine Answers To Life's Most Difficult Questions Comes By Receiving God's Implanted Word. (James 1:21)

"Receive with meekness the implanted word"

- I. Finding Divine Answers To Life's Most Difficult Questions Requires Us To <u>Believe</u> God's Word. (James 1:18)
 - 1. Believing God's Word Means Accepting His Sovereign Will Over Our Lives. (James 1:18a) "Of His own will He brought us fourth"
 - 2. Believing God's Word Requires Us To Be A True <u>Believer</u>. (James 1:18b) "He brought us forth"
 - 3. Believing God's Word Means Believing It Is <u>All True</u>. (James 1:18c) "By the word of truth"
 - 4. Believing God's Word Is <u>Purposeful</u>, Not Just Academic. "That we might be a kind of first **fruits** of His creatures"
- II. Finding Divine Answers To Life's Most Difficult Questions Requires Us To <u>Listen</u> To God's Word. (James 1:19-20)
 - 1. A Godly Listener Is Someone Who Is <u>Eager</u> To Hear The Word of God. (James 1:19a) "Let Every man be **swift** to hear"
 - 2. A Godly Listener Is Someone Who Hears Eagerly And Speaks <u>Hesitantly</u>. (James 1:19b) "Slow to speak"
 - 3. A Godly Listener Is Someone Who Hears The Word Objectively Without Becoming Emotionally Threatened Or Defensive. (James 1:19c-20) "Slow to wrath"
- III. Finding Divine Answers To Life's Most Difficult Questions Requires Us To Receive God's Word. (James 1:21)
 - 1. If You Want To Hungerly Receive God's Word, Don't Ruin Your <u>Appetite</u> With Filthy Hands. (James 1:21a)

 "Therefore lay aside all filthiness"
 - 2. If You Want To Receive God's Word, You Can't Be <u>Filled Up</u> With Ugly Stuff. (James 1:21b) "Overflow of wickedness"
 - 3. If You Want To Receive God's Word, Do So With Meekness. (James 1:21c) "Receive with meekness the implanted word"
 - 4. If You Want To Receive God's Word You Have To Let It Take Root. (James 1:21d) "Receive... the implanted word"



- IV. Finding Divine Answers To Life's Most Difficult Questions Requires Us To Apply God's Word. (James 1:22-27)
 - 1. Applying God's Word Is Not An Option. (James 1:22a) "Be doers of the word"
 - 2. The Fact Is: We Are Flat Out <u>Deceiving</u> Ourselves If We Hear God's Word And Refuse To Apply It. (James 1:22b)

 "Be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving ourselves"
 - 3. Refusing To Apply God's Word As A Christian Means You Have "Spiritual <u>Alzheimer's</u> Disease." (James 1:22c-24)
 - 4. Applying God's Word To Our Lives Might Just Make You <u>Happy</u>. (James 1:25) "This one will be **blessed**"

Conclusion: How We Respond To God's Word Is A <u>Test</u> As To Your True Religion. (James 1:26-27)
