Introduction: Death Is Always A Possibility For The Believer. (2 Cor. 4:10-12)

*“For we who live are always delivered unto death for Jesus’ sake...
So then death is working in us.”*

I. Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks On Our Door, The Best Is Yet To Come. (2 Cor. 4:13-18)

*“Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing,
yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.”*

II. Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks On Our Door, A Better Place Awaits Us. (2 Cor. 5:1)

*“For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God,
a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.”*

III. Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks On Our Door, A Better Body Awaits Us. (2 Cor. 5:2-3)

*“For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed
with our habitation which is from heaven.”*

IV. Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks On Our Door, A Better Life Awaits Us. (2 Cor. 5:4-5)

*“For we who are in this tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed,
but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life.”*

V. Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks On Our Door, A Better Church Awaits Us. (2 Cor. 5:6-9)

*“So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body,
we are absent from the Lord.”*

Conclusion: Our Hope In The Resurrection Reminds Us That When Death Knocks At Our Door, We Will All Stand Before The Judgement Seat Of Christ. (2 Cor. 5:10)
