“For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy.”

II. A True Minister’s Heart Is Marked With A Sense Of Paternal _____.
(2 Cor. 11:3-4)
*“But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness,
so your minds may be corrupted.”*

III. A True Minister’s Heart Is Marked With A Sense Of Open _____. (2 Cor. 11:5-6)
*“For I consider that I am not at all inferior to the most eminent apostles.
Even though I am untrained in speech, yet I am not in knowledge.
But we have been thoroughly **manifested** among you in all things.”*

IV. A True Minister’s Heart Is Marked By A Genuine _____ Nature. (2 Cor. 11:7-9)
*“Did I commit sin in humbling myself that you might be exalted, because I preached the gospel of
God to you free of charge? I robbed other churches,
taking wages from them to minister to you... I was a burden to no one.”*

V. A True Minister’s Heart Is Marked With Unconditional _____. (2 Cor. 11:10-11)
*“As the truth of Christ is in me, no one shall stop me from this boasting in the
regions of Achaia. Why? Because I do not love you? God knows!”*

Conclusion: A True Minister’s Heart Must Be Marked With True _____.
(2 Cor. 11:12) *“But what I do, I will also continue to do.”*
